

## The Bow Tie Block.

Please do not use anything other than quilting weight cotton fabric i.e. no curtaining, stretch, suiting or upholstery fabrics. We are also unable to use blocks that include licensed fabrics.

The block is made by using a bright print fabric and a background fabric in plain black, white, red, blue or green. (Very low volume background such as white on white are acceptable).

### Cutting instructions:

2 x 6.5" squares of bright fabric

2 x 6.5" squares of background fabric

2 x 3.5" squares of your bright fabric

Draw a diagonal line across the small print squares from corner to corner.

Lay the small print square on one corner of the background square and sew on the line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the stitched line and press the small remaining triangle outwards.





Arrange the four squares into a bow tie shape. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Stitch the top and bottom pairs together and press towards the large print square. Stitch the two pairs together to form the completed block.



The block should measure 12.5"
