### Chandelier Beads

This block, also known as Beads, is a free pattern on Jordan Fabrics ' website.

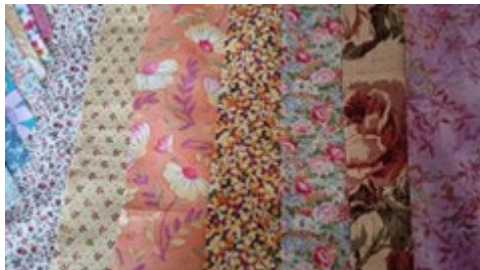


There are two ways to cut for this block. Please read cutting instructions carefully.

**Before you get started, please carefully read through all the fabric requirements and method. Also, please check that your sewing machine is sewing correctly i.e. the tension - make sure it's not gathering the fabric or that the base thread is lying on the fabric's surface.**

### FABRIC TYPE

Please use only quilting-weight cotton fabric, i.e., no curtaining, stretch, suiting, or upholstery fabrics. We are also unable to use blocks that include licensed fabrics.



### COLOUR CHOICE

FLORALS, in any colour, large or small print see above (a small amount of white in the floral is fine) BACKGROUND, White, or white on white.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Using strip unit method using fat quarter strips:

Floral Fabric cut a strip 5" x 22" and 2½" x 22"

White Fabric cut a strip 7" x 22" and 2 strips of 2½" x 22"

### Using Scraps

5" square floral x1

2½" square floral x2

2½" x 7" white x2

2½" x 5" white x2

## METHOD 1. Strips

Please check your quarter inch is correct before starting.

1. Make a strip unit using a 5" floral strip with a 2½" white strip on each side it will measure 22" x 9".



2. Press toward the floral being careful not to distort the unit. Sub cut into 5" segments they will measure 9"x5".



3. Join a 2½" floral to a 7" white strip it will measure 22"x 9". Press toward the floral.



4. Sub cut into 2½" segments they will measure 9" x 2½".



5. Lay out the 3 sections as below. Stitch, nesting the 2 seams, and press to one side. The block should measure 9" square and you will get 4 blocks from each strip set.



## METHOD 2. Scraps

1. Sew a 5" white strip to both sides of the floral 5" square. Press to floral.
2. Sew the 2½" floral squares to one end of the 7" white strips. Press to the floral.
3. Lay the pieces out as in photo above.
4. Join the rows, nesting the seams.
5. Press to the same side.



## POSTAGE

Please carefully check the postage – the cost depends on the envelope's size, weight and thickness. A standard stamp only covers 100g, 0.5cm thick letter. A large letter stamp only covers up to 100g. For anything heavier than 100g, you'll need a different stamp. Underpayment incurs penalty charges (currently around £1.50 per parcel), which stack up quickly. Also, standard stamps without the barcode strips are no longer valid. Please don't use them, or penalty charges will be imposed by Royal Mail. If in doubt, please check at a post office.
