

LET'S TWIST AGAIN



You will need...

12 ½" square of plain black **or** white fabric

6 strips of bright fabrics 13" x 2 ½" (if narrower strips are used, make up width to approx 13"..
no strips to be wider than 2 ½")

12 ½" square ruler.

Blocks can be all the same colourway or a mix of colours as long as they are bright.

Prewashing your black & coloureds advisable.

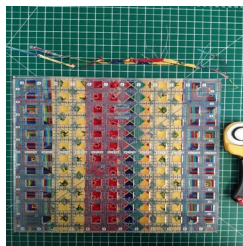
Lay out your strips randomly. (Please note order changed to proceed)



Stitch strips together using a **very scant ¼"**. Press well with seams to one side.



Using your square ruler trim to 12 ½" (or can use the measurements on your cutting board for squaring up)



Pin your white or black fabric right sides together with your striped piece.



Machine all round with a scant 1/4".

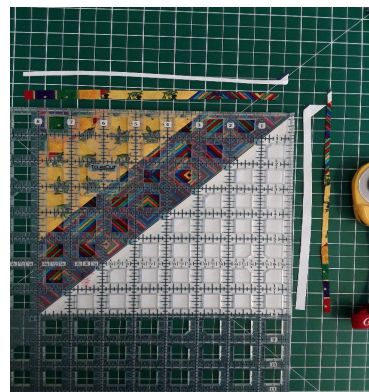


Cut into quarters diagonally.



Open each block and press seams to one side.

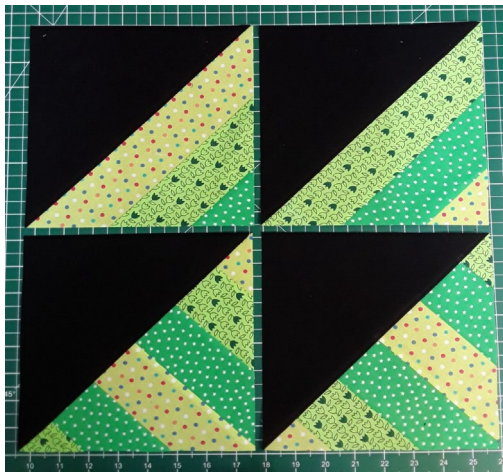
Trim each block to **8" square, placing the diagonal line on the ruler with the seam.**



You will now have four 8" blocks ready for posting.
